## Supply List for Watercolor Class

### 1. Paints

Divided into warm and cool colors - 2 in each of the primary colors  
With these 8 colors you can mixed a vast amount of other colors. For a beginner this  
will give you a clear understanding of color and how to mix and blend.

\* NOTE - I realize that art supplies are expensive. Professional grade may cost more up front but you  
will use less paint due to the high pigment content in the paint and save money in the long run.

### Paints to buy:

Recommend Brands- Windsor & Newton, Daniel Smith, Rembrandt, DaVinci, Holbein

\*NOTE - There are many more brands to choose. Check your local stores for pricing. I found on line  
gives a better deal. But if you have a coupon you may find a good deal in the store.

1. Blues
  - a. French Ultramarine Blue
  - b. Cerulean Blue
2. Red
  - a. Alizarin Crimson
  - b. Cadmium Red
3. Yellow
  - a. New Gamboge
  - b. Cadmium yellow
4. Earth Colors
  - a. Burnt Umber
  - c. Yellow Ochre

\* Optional colors - Permanent Rose, Cobalt Blue, Permanent Sap Green

**NOTE - If you ave paints do not buy more we will work with the colors you have.**

### 2. Brushes

In the beginning your will only need a few brushes. find a Sable/Synthetic Blend. or a  
synthetic sable. make sure it has a clean point. No stray bristles.

1. Round - #6, #8, #10 & #12
2. Flat - 1/2 inch & 1inch

**NOTE - If you ave paints and/or brushes do not buy more we will work with the colors you have.**

## 3. Palette

Jones or Richeson Palette work well. Make sure it has a cover and a generous space for mixing paint in the center.

## 4. Paper

\* To begin we will use a watercolor block.

Aquarelle Arches or Strathmore #140lb watercolor block

## 6. Tools

xacto knife

Utility knife

Ruler

Scissor

Tape - 2 inch clear mailing tape

## 7. Other supplies

Towel Paper - clear white or facial tissue

large containers for rinsing brushes

xacto kknife

scissors

ruler - metal with cork backing 12inch
